- Kept New Equipment operations running through a disruptive JD Edwards (JDE) rollout, using temporary paper tickets while resolving workflow bottlenecks. Protected hundreds of thousands of dollars in orders from potential cancellation.
- Investigated relationships among JDE work orders, sales orders, and configured items to understand statuses and determine how to advance orders. Applied those findings to troubleshoot stuck orders and reduce inefficiencies that nearly halted New Equipment operations.
- Wrote the new operating procedures and trained two New Equipment employees and the president/CEO, plus five other employees on procedures for their functions. Caught and corrected hundreds of errors before orders left the building.
- Resolved a parts-traceability gap Kresl had pursued for over a year. Gained access to previously unavailable JDE processes during a Harrington site visit and learned to connect hoist serial numbers to parts and suppliers.
- Solely represented Kresl's operational and technology needs with manufacturer leadership, including the VP of Operations, Director of Hoist Production, and CEO.
- Lead companywide equipment and software troubleshooting, coordinate the outside IT provider, and evaluate new technology. Led updates to the company website.
